Oobleck





Recipe:

- 1 cup water
- 1.5-2 cups corn starch
- a few drops of food coloring of your choice

Steps

- Start with the water in a bowl (or wading pool!) and add the cornstarch a bit at a time.
- Keep stirring until it has a gooey consistency.
 You may want to use your hands.
- When the oobleck is just right, slowly add food coloring, if you want. This can be a challenge to get it mixed properly.
- Play with it.

 How is Bartholomew and the Oobleck similar or different from Cloudy with a Chance of Meatballs?


Why does the king get angry at the weather?
